## From the President of Lloyd's Illinois, Inc. Maryanne Swaim, CPCU, ARM

Dear ALB Members and insurance colleagues:

I have just returned from the 2005 Risk and Insurance Managers Society (RIMS) convention, held in Philadelphia. The Lloyd's cocktail reception on Sunday evening was hosted by Lloyd's Chairman Lord Peter Levene, Director of Worldwide Markets Julian James, and President and Director of Lloyd's America Wendy Baker. More than 450 people attended. Many clients of Lloyd's, along with underwriters and brokers from the UK, US and Canada all had a marvelous opportunity to network with one another.

### Lloyd's 2004 Profits

Lord Levene recently announced 2004 profits for Lloyd's of \$2.56 billion, a remarkable performance in a year that saw the highest-ever losses in the insurance industry from numerous natural catastrophes.

"A few years ago, such a performance would have been unthinkable," Lord Levene recently said. "Our reputation has been built on our security, our willingness to take on difficult risks, and our willingness to pay. The way the market

has responded to last year's natural catastrophes shows why our reputation is so strong."

Lloyd's strong overall performance, even when faced with the extreme losses of 2004, has allowed it to keep its A (excellent) rating from A.M. Best, and its A (strong) rating from Fitch and Standard & Poor's.

### Restoring Confidence

Lord Levene also recently outlined a four point plan for restoring confidence in the insurance industry. The industry should eliminate conflicts of interest and increase transparency; work with regulators to develop and require adoption of ethical principles of behavior; communicate more effectively to those outside the industry how it works; and work with boards of directors and chief executives to demonstrate that managing risk seriously is a critical element of good corporate governance.
